The Panic Squad is committed to producing genuine, wholesome laughter. Not a nervous chuckle solicited by below the belt material. They are determined to send a strong message stating, "it's okay to be clean", through comedy that is extremely funny, but also non-offensive and all-inclusive. Their performances prove that real comedy doesn't need to cross any lines or go to the gutter to be truly great.

The Panic Squad began performing improv comedy as a team in 1996, doing shows for local churches and businesses. Realizing a growing demand for their brand of quick-witted, family friendly hilarity, the team quickly began to take their comedy to larger audiences. They've made a name for themselves by performing at national conferences, corporate events, and youth gatherings across Canada and the U.S., as well as for area schools, churches and businesses.
